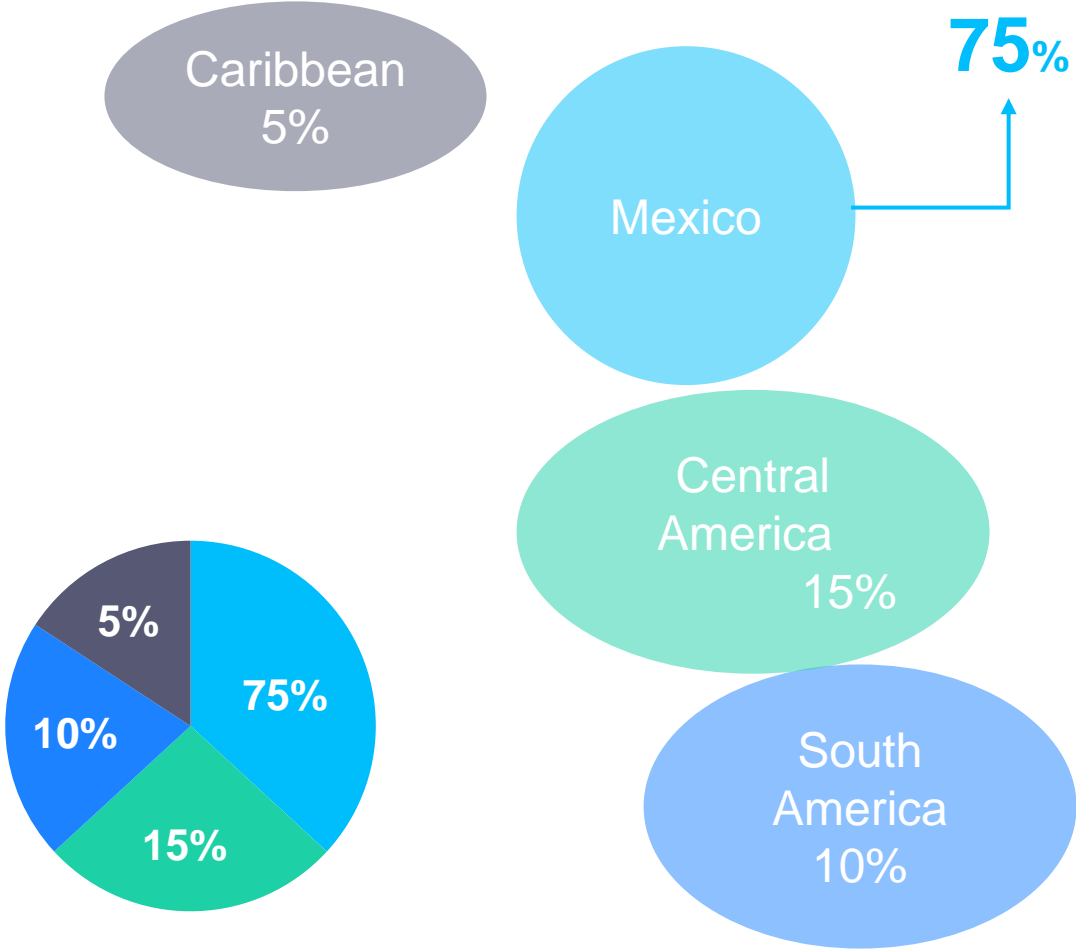
- 2022 Passengers 54 Million on 26 Carriers
